At the February 15, 2022 Wharf District Council (WDC) meeting, George Kalogiannis, an owner of For Five Boston LLC, came before the Council requesting a letter of support from the Council to the Boston Licensing Board for a Common Victualler's License at 200 State Street.

The Coffee Kiosk will be located in the 200 State Street building lobby to the left of the main entrance, with a back-room support area for preparation, ware-washing and storage. There will be no changes to the building's exterior's stone and glass front. The Coffee Kiosk will operate from this location Monday – Sunday, 7am-7pm.

Based on the presentation by Mr. Kalogiannis, the Wharf District Council voted to support the request the request for a Common Victualler's License. With our support, we request management effectively control the approved times and conditions of operation and prevent unnecessary noise and rowdiness.
