At the January 18, 2022 Wharf District Council (WDC) meeting, Tito Jackson, owner, came before the Council requesting a letter of support from the Council to the Boston Licensing Board, for the transfer of the existing liquor license at 150 State Street to a new entity, owned by Mr. Jackson.
